As scientists we will learn about a variety of different materials and their properties. Selecting the best one to make a castle.

As **designers** we will design and create a fortress fit for a King using the knowledge we have gained in our science lessons.

As communicators we will discuss our ideas and share our views by taking turns.

As athletes we will develop our co-ordination through our throwing and catching skills. We will develop our balance through running and jumping.

As **technicians** we will research different castles and present this information in a PowerPoint.
