#### • AUTUMN TERM TOPICS

This term FS/KS1 are studying: 'FAMILY, FRIENDS & NEIGHBOURS' and 'FIRE & DRAGONS', Y3 & Y4 are studying 'THE MAYA CULTURE' and Y5 & Y6 are studying 'THE GREEKS'.

#### • Y5&6 RESIDENTIAL VISITS TO SWANAGE 2020

Due to pupil numbers and logistics, school proposes returning to its former combined Y5&6 Residential Visit to Swanage in June 2020, about which, more details later this term.

#### • HOMEWORK

A paper copy of the school's HOMEWORK POLICY is to be sent home to ALL FAMILIES at the beginning of this term. There is also a copy on the school's website. The POLICY contains advice and guidance on HOW TO SUPPORT CHILDREN'S LEARNING OUT (and in) SCHOOL and also includes details of: homework subject matter/content, dates/times, degree and nature of support. The setting of formal homework this term begins during the week commencing SEPTEMBER 16<sup>th</sup> and times of teachers' weekly 'Homework Surgeries', will be available from Mrs Sansbury, Mrs Smith and Mrs Clarke shortly.

#### • PE/GAMES/GYMNASTICS/SWIMMING

Weekly PE lessons for pupils at Dalesdown and/or on the school field, with specialist Horsham Leisurelink PE coach, Mrs Jagota begin on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> September. Mrs Jagota will also be teaching specialist PE here on Thursday afternoons too, and will be joined by two more specialist representatives from Horsham Leisurelink, as part of the school's after-school PE/Sport programme throughout the academic year.

Starting again this Autumn term, school has organised blocked swimming sessions for pupils at The Towers, on Fridays, with specialist coaching, starting on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> September with Y2 pupils. Packed lunches have been arranged with Easylunches.

There will be a third morning in school on **Thursday 21st November** to meet with Mrs Clarke to discuss and report individual pupil progress to respective parents. ## - A Reminder on Pupils' Daily Welfare & Well Being

-in keeping with local and national guidelines/directives, for the most part.

#### **Emergency Contact Numbers**

Please would all families make sure the school has up to date information on contact numbers, should there ever be an urgent matter and/or emergency arising during the school day.

#### School Collection at 3:30pm

Always inform the school of any alternative arrangements for children being collected at the end of the school day.

#### Registration

In the event of pupils arriving at school after 8.55am registration and/or needing to be collected from school before 3:30pm, parents must register at Office via School House first.

#### Medication

ALL medication for children, and instructions for its use, must be given by parents to the School Office for recording and appropriate storage AND SCHOOL MUST BE UPDATED IMMEDIATELY IF, AS and WHEN CIRCUMSTANCES/ CONDITIONS CHANGE.. This includes inhalers for asthma suffers.

### Injuries

Children who suffer 'minor' head injuries during the school day receive written notification from the school on the day for their parents' information. The parents of infant pupils are also informed by respective classteachers at the end of the day

### Welfare & Concerns

If, at anytime, parents see anything *untoward* regarding pupils' safety and/or wellbeing, please let the school know *immediately*.

### Very Bad Weather Conditions

In the event of very wet and/or very windy weather, all children come and go through the JUNIOR ENTRANCE at the start and end of the school day.

### Coats in School

We trust children will have coats in school every day.

#### PUPILS' SAFETY

Please would all parents and carers try to use the junior gate, generally attended by members of staff, and the crossing point immediately in front of it, at the start and end of school each day.
