Dear Parents and Carers,

Firstly, a very warm welcome back to the new year to all families, we hope that you enjoyed a good break over the Christmas holidays and that you are looking forward to all that is planned for 2022. Secondly, we must thank you for your very generous gifts, we are blessed to be a school with such considerate families.

#### Covid/Omicron

We are mindful of the current Covid/Omicron situation and are following all of the current recommendations and guidelines from the DfE and WSCC and continuing with our enhanced cleaning and additional ventilation throughout the day

Following the latest advice from DfE on 2.1.22, it remains a legal requirement for children to be in school. Please see the document on the school website for further information.

If your children are required to be at home <u>due to Covid infection but well enough</u> <u>to learn</u>, their learning can be accessed via Google classroom, which continues to have the links and lessons for that day for each class. This will include a daily live stream starter session and ask that your children click the appropriate link that day. More information available on Google classrooms.

#### <u>Curriculum</u>

Thank you for your interest in joining our curriculum working party, we will be in contact over the next couple of weeks to arrange our first meeting with Governors and children.

This term in Mouse Class, children will be answering the questions 'What lives at the bottom of the sea?' and 'Does chocolate really grow on trees?' Squirrel Class are learning about 'Mighty Metals' and discovering if they could live without electricity for a day. The wise Owl Class will be exploring 'How has conflict impacted our lives?'

#### After School Clubs

This term, thanks to the generosity of staff and friends in the local community, we are delighted to be able to offer four afterschool clubs. These will commence the week beginning 10<sup>th</sup> January and will include Chess for Y3-Y6 on Tuesdays,

Dance/Drama for Y3-Y6 on Wednesdays, Sports for Y1-Y6 on Thursdays and Craft for Y1-Y6 on Fridays.

We would ask that when a child has signed up for a club they attend weekly, unless there is a good reason e.g. illness or a medical appointment.

#### <u>Y6 Residential</u>

The residential trip for Y6 in Chichester is planned for 23-26 May 2022 (after KS2 SATs and before half term) to include 3 nights away. We will update you with more information shortly.

#### Swimming Sessions

We are pleased to continue our partnership with Steyning Grammar School and 'MXT Swimming' to offer swimming sessions in the Spring term for Y3 and Y4. Please remember your child will need a verruca sock if they have a verruca and a swimming hat (they will not be permitted to swim without a hat). Transport will be provided by minibus, and children are asked to wear a mask on the minibus. If your child does not have a mask, we have a supply of disposable ones in school.
